BOCCE COURT RULES & GUIDELINES

1. Individuals **UNDER THE AGE OF 18 MUST BE** accompanied by a parent or legal guardian to use the Bocce Courts.
2. The General Rules and Regulations of the Park District govern the use of the Bocce Courts.
3. **BOARDMAN PARK IS ALCOHOL FREE.**

RESERVATIONS FOR THE BOCCE COURTS:

1. Court reservations shall be limited to not more than 30 days in advance, unless the individual or group is reserving another Park District facility, i.e. Indoor Meeting Room or Open-Air Pavilion for the same date.
2. Reservable Time-Slots:
 - 12 PM – 1:30 PM
 - 2 PM – 3:30 PM
 - 4 PM – 5:30 PM
 - 6 PM – 7:30 PM
 - 8 PM – 9:30 PM
3. Individuals or Groups may reserve not more two (2) Time-Slots per Reservation for a total of 3 hours.
4. The Fee for each 1.5 hour time-slot:
 - 1 Court - \$10.00.
 - 2 Courts - \$15.00, both Courts reserved for the same Time-Slot.
5. Fees must be paid within 10 days from the date the Reservation is made. If the date of the Reservation is less than 10 days from the date that it is made, the fee must be paid at that time.
6. When making a Reservation for the Bocce Court (s), the individual or group must indicate whether they will bring their own Bocce Set (s) or use the Bocce Set (s) owned by the Park District.
7. The Park District will provide Bocce Set (s) upon request, but will require the individual or group requesting the Set (s) to leave a valid Driver's license as a security deposit until the Set is returned in satisfactory condition.
8. Reservations can be made at the Park Office or by calling the Office – 330.726.8105. The Office is open Monday through Friday, from 9 AM to 4:30 PM.

OPEN PLAY:

1. Individuals or groups may sign up for Open Play only during those Time-Slots that have not been reserved or when there are no leagues scheduled.
2. Players may sign up for only one (1) 1.5 hours Time-Slot at a time.
3. Players shall be limited to two (2) 1.5 hour Time-Slots per day.
4. There is no charge for Open Play.
5. Players need to provide their own Bocce Sets.

OTHER RULES & GUIDELINES:

1. Individuals or groups wanting to sign up for Open Play must sign up on the Daily Sign Up sheet that will be posted at the Bocce Court Pavilion, which will be monitored by a Park Caretaker and/or Custodian on duty.
2. The Bocce Courts are designed and maintained for the game of Bocce only; therefore, there shall be no other type of activity in the Bocce Courts.
3. Bocce Balls shall be used properly and **ONLY** for Bocce.
4. Players must wear soft soled shoes. Shoes that will disrupt or damage the Court surface are not permitted.
5. Please be informed – **PLAY AT YOUR OWN RISK.**
